TECHNO 293 UK LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION

The Techno 293 UK Class Association (hereafter the TCA) is organising a competition to select the design for the new Techno 293 UK Class Association logo, to be used on all official correspondence, event literature, press releases and the Techno UK Website as well as Windsurfing Clothing (hoodies, rash vests and T-shirts).

1. Presentation

1.1 The design shall include the current T293 logo  somewhere in the design.

1.2 The design specs: -

For a small logo: max height 80mm, max length 120mm

For a large logo: max height 350mm, max length 320mm

Maximum of 7 different colours

1.3 The designs will be submitted electronically to logo.entry@techno293.org.uk

1.4 The designs may be produced electronically or hand drawn (and submitted via scanning).

2. Candidates

Participation in this competition is open to all Techno UK Members. Only one application per candidate will be allowed.

3. Competition

The contest includes the following phases:

3.1 Design Submission Phase: from Monday 17th January 2011 to Monday 28th February 2011

3.2 Sort-listing: Designs for the Techno UK Members voting will be short-listed between Tues 1st March to Friday 4th March by the current TCA Committee. All short-listed designs will be submitted to www.techno293.org.uk for viewing and voting by Monday 7th March.

3.3 Design voting phase: from Monday 7th March 2011 to Monday 21st March 2011

Designs can be submitted to logo.entry@techno293.org.uk

The email address for voting will be announced once the vote site opens. A short list of designs will be put forward for voting by Techno UK Members.

3.4 Voting phase for internet users: from Monday 7th March 2011 to Monday 21st March 2011

The voting phase for internet users will run from Monday 7th March 2011 to Monday 21st March 2011

Internet users will vote for their favourite design from among all those presented online.

Each internet user will have one vote per design proposed.

Candidates must fill in the application form that is available on the site www.techno293.org.uk and submit their design by uploading onto the same site their version of the design logo, accompanied by a brief written description of the design.

Incomplete applications and those sent after midnight on 28th February (based on the date and time of reception of these items) will be refused.

3.5 No modifications will be made to the design of the logo chosen by the jury during its making, with the exception of possible modifications for technical or visibility reasons.

3.6 The TCA will inform the winner/runner up of his/her victory prior soon after the voting closes on 21st March.

4. Intellectual property rights

4.1. The candidates acknowledge that the graphic elements sent within the framework of this competition are free of rights.

4.2. The candidates fully guarantee to the TCA that they possess all the rights to the designs submitted within the framework of this competition and that these designs do not violate any existing copyright or any other intellectual property rights belonging to third parties other than the current T293 logo .

4.3. The winner irrevocably transfers to the TCA all the intellectual property rights to his/her creation, including, but not limited to, the right to transfer, reproduce, copy, publish, alter, adapt, modify or distribute his/her creation, in any currently existing or future medium or form, and agrees that his/her creation will be the exclusive property of the TCA.

5. Prizes

5.1. The winner & runner up will receive the following prize:

Winner: A hoodie with the winners design logo on.

Runner up: A T-shirt with the runner up design logo on

5.2 The prizes will be presented at the prize giving ceremony of the first UKWA Inland competition of the season at Pitsford, 15th/16th April 2011.

5.3 Winner/runner up will be required to grant permission to allow their photos posted on the Techno UK website, along with other press releases.
